

Preferred Oral Nutritional Supplements (ONS) for Adults

- Products listed below in green can be initiated in primary care after 'MUST' screening & appropriate first line 'Food First' treatment in line with 'Six Steps to Prescribing ONS'.
- The products on this list have been evaluated as the most cost-effective prescribing choices
- The products listed in **blue** overleaf should only be prescribed following assessment/ recommendation by a dietitian.
- Initially prescribe an **ONS starter pack** or **one week's supply** in a variety of flavours to help people identify their preferred flavours.
- Prescribe a minimum of 600kcal/day initially (usually 2 servings, prescribe between meals)
- Prescribe ONS as acute NOT repeat prescriptions.
- ONS prescriptions should be reviewed every 3 months as a minimum. If patients fail to engage
 or do not attend two consecutive ONS reviews the ONS prescription should be stopped and the
 patient informed.

1st Line Powdered ONS

Prescribe standard versions if individual can drink 2 x 200ml servings per day and is **able to prepare milkshakes from powder** (or has support who could prepare the drinks).

If a lower volume is required prescribe **compact** versions.

2nd Line Twice Daily Ready To Drink milkshake ONS

Only prescribe if individual cannot prepare milkshake from powder so requires ready to drink supplement and can drink 2 x 200ml servings per day (recommended dose 2 x 200ml bottles per day)

2nd Line Once Daily Ready To Drink compact milkshake ONS

Only prescribe if individual cannot prepare milkshake from powder so requires ready to drink and/or low volume ONS (recommended dose 1 bottle per day)
