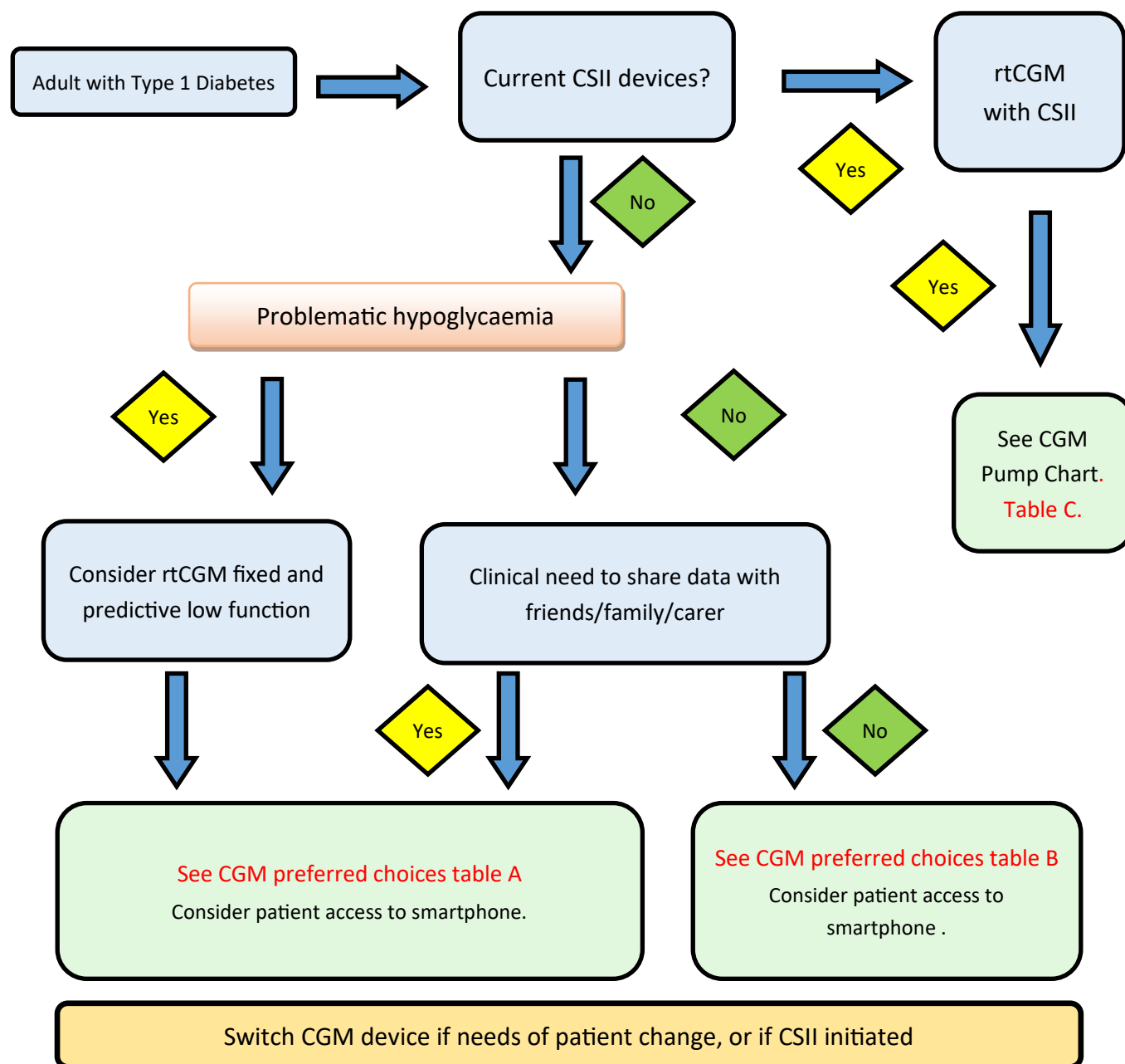


A Flow Chart To Support Clinical Decision Making for CGM Devices in Adults with Type 1 Diabetes and Pregnant Women.



Monitoring and review:

The use of a CGM system should be reviewed by the specialist team at 12 months after initiation or sooner if there is clinical need.

Consider:






- Is rtCGM being used 70 % of time/daily/calibrated?
- Is there evidence of sustained improvement e.g. hypoglycaemia reduction, increased time in range?
- Other problems identified e.g. skin reactions, over/under ordering of sensors?

Pregnant women: review rtCGM after 12 months to ensure cost-effective device chosen

Pregnant women requiring insulin but who are not diagnosed with Type 1 diabetes who have either:
Problematic hypoglycaemia
Or
Unstable, blood glucose causing concern

Preferred CGM Choices For Pregnant Women with NON Type 1 Diabetes requiring insulin with problematic severe hypoglycaemia or unstable blood glucose.

Real Time CGM is recommended for this patient group.
