<p>Recommendations:</p> <p>The Surrey Prescribing Clinical Network does not routinely recommend the use of oral and non-oral combination therapy for erectile dysfunction due to the limited evidence available to support their use.</p> <p>The use of these treatments in combination are considered BLACK on the prescribing Advisory Database.</p>	
<p>Key Considerations:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • PCN requested to consider the use of combination treatments for those patients who had not responded or had a sub-optimal response to monotherapy. • The members noted that there is no robust controlled trial data supporting the use of these treatments in combination and the fact that they are also not licensed in combination.
