<p>Recommendations: The PCN recommends alirocumab for treating primary hypercholesterolaemia and mixed dyslipidaemia in line with NICE TA393 (June 2016)</p> <p>Prescribing will be initiated and treatment continued by specialists with training in lipid management and notification of initiation and continuation of treatment will be via the Blueteq database.</p> <p>Alirocumab will be considered RED on the traffic light system</p>
